

## Lower Providence Rod & Gun Club Hunter/Trapper Education Information Sheet

- a) There is no fee for the course. (We start with the best news first ☺)
- b) To complete the course, the student must attend all of the classes of a single course **in their entirety. No exceptions!**
- c) Be there 15 minutes early to complete registration forms and receive course materials. **We need a parent or guardian to sign the registration form if the student is under 18.** After the parent has signed the form, they may stay or leave as they wish.
- d) The student does **not** need to bring a birth certificate or other ID to the course.
- e) Students **should not** bring personal firearms to the class.
